Exonuclease Activity (Radioactivity Release) - A 50 μ l reaction in CutSmart® Buffer containing 1 μ g of a mixture of single and double -stranded [3 H] *E. coli* DNA and a minimum of 15 units of Cac8I incubated for 4 hours at 37°C releases <0.2% of the total radioactivity.

Ligation and Recutting (Terminal Integrity) - After a 5-fold over-digestion of Lambda DNA with Cac8I, \sim 75% of the DNA fragments can be ligated with T4 DNA ligase in 16 hours at 16°C. Of these ligated fragments, >95% can be recut with Cac8I.

Non-Specific DNase Activity (16 Hour) - A 50 µl reaction in CutSmart® Buffer containing 1 µg of Lambda DNA and a minimum of 25 units of Cac8I incubated for 16 hours at 37°C results in a DNA pattern free of detectable nuclease degradation as determined by agarose gel electrophoresis.
